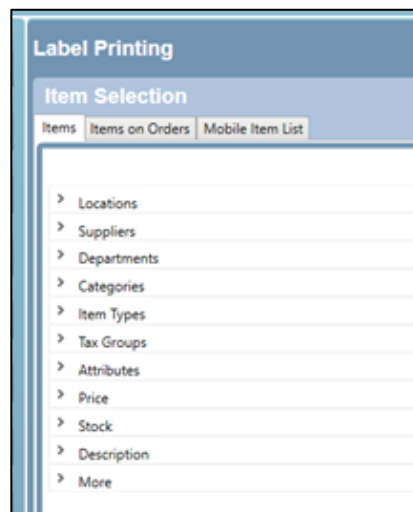
Label Printing

Please Note - To use this new module, you will need to ensure the new Role Action is enabled for your required users.

1. Item Label Printing Module

A new module is now available, located under Inventory>Items which provides you with the ability to print labels from a variety of filters. Item searches, Items on Orders and items from a Mobile Item List can all be filtered to create a list of items to print.

OpSuite Mobile

1. Mobile - Creation of Item Lists

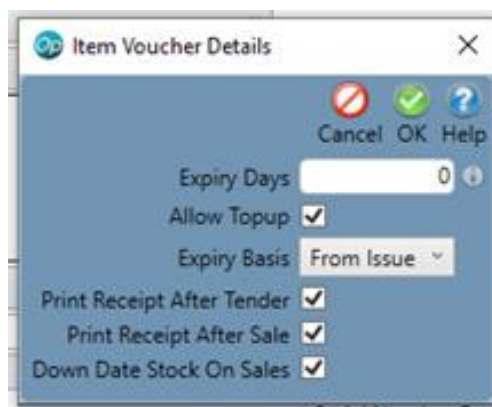
A new module is now available in OpSuite Mobile. You are now able to create Item Lists on the handheld devices by scanning items to generate a list which can then be retrieved for label printing in the new Item Label Printing module in OpSuite's back office.

Vouchers

1. Voucher Items now have the option to not down date stock

You can now use this new option in 'Item Voucher Details' titled 'Down Date Stock On Sales.' By default this will be disabled, however, if you prefer for the stock to be down dated, simply enable this option by navigating to 'Voucher Item Details' on the Voucher Item card.



2. Label Design Name Now Displayed Next To Label

For ease of identification in the Label Design module, the label name is now displayed to the side of the label.



Purchasing

1. Creating A Purchase Order From Stock Turn - Now Allows You To Update Min. & Max. Reorder Levels

In the Purchasing module, where you are able to create a Purchase Order based solely on the stock turn of products, the new enhancement now also allows you to update min and max reorder levels from within the module.
