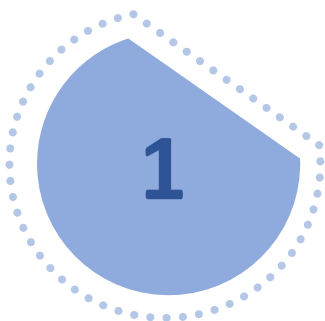


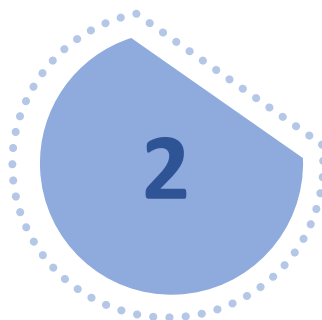
Using the OpSuite WPF application

The OpSuite WPF application has been designed to look and feel very similar to the current Silverlight application to avoid the need for user retraining. It also removes the shackles of the web browser whilst still harnessing the power of cloud technology. The design of the new platform has encompassed some subtle changes to maximise usage going forward. This short document highlights these refined changes to help users in the transition from Silverlight to WPF.

Subtle differences in OpSuite WPF



Subtle colour changes on the KPI dashboard



Printing Standard Reports require the user to choose Print Preview > Print



Role Manager Navigation is now located in "Setup"



No browser back option, users can use the "Cancel" button on each window.



Multiple OpSuite WPF applications can be open and used independently for ease of navigation

Cut, Copy and Paste is available throughout OpSuite

Certificate installation requirements for Internet Explorer to email Purchase Orders and Supplier Credit Requests is no longer required

Small updates can be deployed throughout the day without the need for an overnight deployment

Users can right click on the Standard Report data and choose their export options, Print Layout and refresh the data

Inventory Transfer Lookup now includes NEW columns - # rows, # items and the value of each Transfer

Deleting an Attribute will now provide the user (based on role action) the ability to remove this from the assigned, Location, Department, Category, Supplier, Item or Customer

Modules soon to be available in WPF

The final module to be made available soon in WPF is the Matrix Items module, located under the Inventory main menu.

Known WPF issues currently being addressed

Item Label Designer – Label Template misalignment. Comparing labels designs from Silverlight, printing causes misalignment when printing from WPF.

Purchase Orders - Quick Add - Adding the item the cursor doesn't revert back to the All Product Codes field, causing the user to require to reset the focus.

Calendars – If the application is left open overnight, the calendars throughout the application do not update to the current date. User are required to logout and return.

Active Report – Retail Transaction Report, hyperlink on transaction number fails to navigate to the Active Detailed Sales report for this transaction.

Customer Lookup – Loyalty Card filter (top filter) fails to return the customer record, user can however filter on the Loyalty Card column to return their filtered customer.
